In 2016, David Miller was playing basketball. He drove into the lane to attempt a layup and had his legs cut out from under him. When he fell, the impact fractured and dislocated his hip and broke his femur. David attended aggressive physical therapy re-learning to walk. Four months after the injury, not only was David able to walk, but he went on the walk of his life – down the aisle to marry his tennis doubles partner, Ryann.

Last year, David made his return to the tennis court, winning a bronze medal in singles and a gold in doubles. He works at G&S Foods Warehouse and achieved the rank of Eagle Scout in 2008. In 2015 David was named the Male Athlete of the Year at the State Leadership Conference and in his spare time likes to cook and read.
