Section A- Official Events	Section 2 - Officials Events ADD: 200 Meter Race the Track 700 Meter Race the Track
Section C-Equipment	Section 4 - Equipment 4.3.2 Helmets with the ANSI Z90.4 , SNELL Bicycle standard, American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) standard F-1447 and/or CPSC Standard (Consumer Product Safety Commission bike helmet standard) are required to be worn by all speed skaters at all speed skating competitions.. Proper, safe positioning of helmets on the head will be strictly enforced. Helmets must not be worn on the back of the head, but rather positioned forward, with the front of the helmet slightly above the eyebrows. Helmets must remain on and securely fastened while on the field of play. 4.3.3 Skaters will be issued two cloth or paper numbers. One number will be placed on the back with the other number placed on the left hip. At the discretion of the Technical Delegate or Competition Manager, a helmet number will be optional. Members of a relay team will be issued separate matching numbers for that event (i.e., all members of a team will wear number 3). Color-coded armbands, helmet covers or vests may be used in addition to numbers to help identify relay partners.
