The Hazleton Torch Run and Community Festival for Special Olympics Pennsylvania's Northeast Region is an approximately 3-mile fun run combining the community with members of law enforcement and Special Olympics athletes as they carry the torch that begins a festival at City View Park. After registering at the park, runners are bussed to Harman-Geist Memorial Field where they will weave through downtown Hazleton from back to to City View Park.

The final leg of the run loops around the perimeter of City View Park before the torch lights a cauldron on the park stage that commences festivities in the park including a silent auction of sports memorabilia/experiences, carnival games, pick-up sports games, music, raffles, food trucks, artisan vendors, face painting and more.

About the Law Enforcement Torch Run (LETR) and Special Olympics Pennsylvania

LETR began in 1981 when Wichita, Kansas Police Chief, Richard LaMunyon, created the Torch Run to help law enforcement become active in the community while supporting Special Olympics Kansas. Now known internationally as the Law Enforcement Torch Run for Special Olympics, LETR is the largest grass-roots public awareness and fundraising entity for Special Olympics, supporting the Special Olympics mission of providing year-round sports training and athletic competition for children and adults with intellectual disabilities, giving them continuing opportunities to develop physical fitness, demonstrate courage, experience joy and participate in a sharing of gifts, skills and friendship with their families, and other Special Olympics athletes and the community.
