



SCORING

At UNcathlon, we 'Unify' our athletes with Special Olympics Pennsylvania partners, law enforcement and volunteers to help raise funds to fuel our mission. Teams participate in various competitive sporting events and skills challenges. You might be asking, 'How does my team win?' You win by collecting the most points throughout the event; ranking higher through faster times, longer distances, and higher scores based on the challenge.

The competition consists of the Fundraising competition plus ten (10) sporting events, including:

- Field Goal Kick
- 40-Yard Dash
- Football Distance Throw
- Standing High Jump
- Lateral Jumping
- Football Taps
- Bocce
- Shuttle Run Relay
- Soccer Skills
- Football Target Throw

Fundraising is the FIRST EVENT. And "double points" scoring for that is based on how much money your team raises!

How Scoring Works: Based on a 20-team system

- The type of sport/activity will determine how the team is placed in 1st, 2nd, 3rd...
- For each of the ten rounds, the 1st place team will get 20 points, 2nd place will get 19 points, 3rd place 18 points... and so on.
- The fundraising "event" yields DOUBLE POINTS 1st place fundraising team in a field of 20 gets 40 points, 2nd place gets 38 points, 3rd place gets 36 points, etc.
- Your total points earned from all ten events, combined with your fundraising double points, will be tallied together to get your final score.

Fundraising:

Each team member is encouraged to participate in fundraising "double points" in the FUNdraising challenge. (Sponsors have a head start in fundraising.)

- Any sponsor \$2,500 or higher starts with \$2,500 for the team. Additional fundraising done by the team members will be added to your overall team total
- Sponsorships \$2,500 or lower will be included in the team contribution to the event
- All Peer-to-Peer fundraising by individual team members count toward the team total
- The team that raises the highest amount wins the fundraising event. Each additional team receives points as outlined in the scoring section above.

^{*}Sponsorship credit toward the fundraising event is capped at \$2,500 per team
