Sit in the chair and roll up my sleeve.



I can close my eyes or look away.



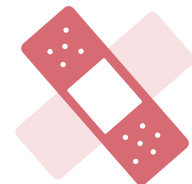
Take a deep breath.

The pharmacist will put a Band-Aid on my arm. I can roll my sleeve down.



Wait a total of 15 minutes.



Schedule 2nd vaccine dose (if 2 shots are required). Then I can leave.

## **We want getting the COVID-19 vaccine to be a comfortable experience for our athletes!**

**Parents/caregivers, here are ways you might help...**

### SCHEDULING AN APPOINTMENT:

- Work with the athlete to schedule an appointment. You can **contact the Office of Developmental Programs (ODP) Vaccination Call Center Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. at 1-800-424-4345**. The call center can connect caregivers and athletes with the closest Rite Aid to make a vaccine appointment.
- Any athlete can take advantage of this great opportunity – they don't have to be registered with ODP!
- If there are any issues with scheduling an appointment, you can contact the ODP Customer Service Line at 1-888-565-9435, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday-Friday.

### ON THE DAY OF THE APPOINTMENT:

- Help the athlete dress in clothing that will give the pharmacist access to the athlete's upper arm.
- Assist athlete with transportation to and from Rite Aid.
- Ensure the athlete arrives on time and with required information.
- Assist the athlete with checking in and completing required paperwork.
- Help the athlete schedule their second dose of vaccine (if necessary).
