SPECIAL OLYMPICS PA TO HOLD PITTSBURGH POLAR PLUNGE & FESTIVAL FEBRUARY 22 & 23

(**Pittsburgh, PA, February 13, 2019**) – The 2019 Pittsburgh Polar Plunge to benefit Special Olympics Pennsylvania (SOPA) will continue its tradition of Freezin' for a Reason on *Friday, February 22 & Saturday, February 23, 2019 at Heinz Field in Pittsburgh, PA*. Registration opens at 9:00am and "splash" time will commence at 11:30am. Join us for the food, festivities, music & interactive entertainment, all while supporting a great cause. The plunge is open to the public and all spectators are welcome free of charge.

The Polar Plunge invites participants of all ages (under 18 requires parent or guardian signature) to take a dip in the "cool pool" that will be set up on Art Rooney Avenue. Plungers can register as an individual or, better yet, join a group of friends and form a Plunge Team. All participants are asked to raise \$50 in pledge support. With this minimum goal met, you are then eligible to receive an official 2019 long sleeved Polar Plunge t-shirt. As your pledges increase you become eligible to earn additional prizes as incentive for your fundraising efforts. Additionally, since jumping into a freezing pool is not for everyone, participants can choose to register for the event as a "Too Chicken to Plunge" participant. This option allows "chickens" the opportunity to still support a worthy cause while staying on dry land.

- COOL SCHOOLS PLUNGE -Heinz Field 100 Art Rooney Ave February 22/9am-12pm
 - The Cool Schools Plunge will kick off our weekend on the right foot! Join us Friday morning as Special Olympics Pennsylvania will welcome 6 local participating schools: Mars, Norwin, Franklin Regional, Hampton, Fox Chapel & Pittsburgh Public High Schools as our guests. Cool Schools Plungers will toss their books aside for the day and jump into an icy cold pool to show their friends, family members and the community how charitable and brave they are. To participate, cool schools plungers must raise a minimum of \$35.00.
- SUPER PLUNGE Heinz Field 100 Art Rooney Ave February 23/7am-5pm
 - The Super Plunge will be an amazing sight to see! A group of 17 brave men and woman will plunge into a cold pool of water more than twenty-four times, over the course of a 10 hour period. Participants must raise a minimum of \$2,500 for the privilege of being called a Super Plunger. Come down and cheer on these Special Olympics PA Super Heroes as they dive into our hearts Saturday.
