## SPECIAL OLYMPICS PA TO CELEBRATE ITS 5TH ANNUAL PHILADELPHIA POLAR PLUNGE AT DREXEL UNIVERSITY ON DECEMBER 6TH

Two Philadelphia Eagles Players to Plunge

**(Norristown, PA, November 29, 2019)** – More than 1,000 plungers will be freezin' for a reason at the fifth annual Philadelphia Polar Plunge to benefit Special Olympics Pennsylvania (SOPA) on Friday, December 6, 2019 at Drexel University Recreation Center, located at 3301 Market Street in Philadelphia, PA.

The event will kick off with the Cool Schools plunge, where a friendly competition between high schools in Philadelphia and Delaware Counties will take place, followed by the Business Plunge presented by Janney, and then the Plunge presented by EMC Outdoor and University Plunges, where two Philadelphia Eagles Players will plunge with their team of participants.

The fun filled day will include a photo booth, an ice sculptor, a backyard connect 4, giant Jenga, cornhole, a costume contest and a chalk installment provided by EMC Outdoor.
